A Chorus Line at New York City Center, National/International Tour (Dance Captain/Female Swing). Choreography credits include The Lightning Thief: The Percy Jackson Musical (Assoc. Choreographer for Broadway/National Tour) A Chorus Line (Asst. Choreographer for Hollywood Bowl, National Tour), A Chorus Line (Director/Choreographer at The Argyle Theater) Virgin Voyages Entertainment (Install Director/Choreographer) and most recently, OKLAHOMA! (Director/Choreographer at Montclair State University).

Tony Jackson-Hood is a dedicated dance educator, performer, and choreographer originally from Philadelphia. His formal training began at the prestigious Philadelphia High School for Creative & Performing Arts and was further enriched by studies at PHILADANCO, The Rock School for Dance Education, and Dance Theatre of Harlem. In 2004, Tony was honored as a Coca-Cola Arts Award Scholar and received a Presidential Scholarship to attend the University of the Arts, where he earned his B.F.A. in Dance in 2008. During his collegiate years, he performed works by esteemed choreographers such as Louis Johnson, Christopher Huggins, Roni Koresh, and Darrell Grand Moultrie. Tony's professional performance career includes credits with Eleone Dance Theatre, Smoke, Lillies & Jade Arts Initiative, Rebecca Davis Dance Company, Ballet Guild of the Lehigh Valley, Dance Del Bello, the Philadelphia Opera, and Philadanco's D/2. From 2017 to 2022, Tony served as the Artistic Director of the Making Moves Dance Collective in Beltsville, Maryland. He currently adjudicates for national dance competitions, including Headliners Dance Championships, On Point Dance National Talent, and American Dance Awards. Since 2017, Tony has been a full-time dance educator with Anne Arundel County Public Schools. He is the Dance Director at Brooklyn Park Middle School, where he leads a thriving public magnet dance program. He is a certified K–12 Dance educator in the state of Maryland. Tony has completed the ABT® Teacher Training Intensive in Pre-Primary through Level 3 of the ABT® National Training Curriculum. In 2023, Tony was named Maryland Dance Educator of the Year (K-12) by the Maryland Dance Education Association, recognized for his excellence in fostering student growth in technique, creativity, and performance. Next month, Tony will graduate with a Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Curriculum & Instruction from the American College of Education, continuing his mission to inspire and uplift through dance education.
