CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION

Our competition is split up into 2 "teams" - Red and Blue - to accommodate the number of entries. This structure helps to keep our competition hours modest, and ensures that studios do not have dancers on more than one stage at a time. Solo entries will compete on the stage in Expo Hall C, and Duo-Production entries will compete on the stage in Expo Hall A. Each session will conclude with an awards ceremony - see the competition schedule for details on what will be announced at each awards!

CONVENTION CLASSES

With your Registration Fee, you get access to 30+ classes all week long - taught by a superstar faculty and designed for all ages and ability levels (ages listed are simply a guideline, all classes are open). Please be sure to have your red convention bracelet on in order to be admitted to the convention rooms! Parent Observer bands can be purchased at the Merchandise Booth. Fun fact - our faculty will be nominating ADA in Class Ambassadors for our Fall workshops from classes!

DANCE OFF & GALA

The top-scoring entries from each category (Solo, Duo/Trio, Small Group, Large Group, etc) will perform once again in the exciting National Championship Dance Off! During the Awards Gala later that evening, high score winners in each category will be recognized, and the Elite Six will be selected to re-compete live for our gala audience - adding even more entertainment to the evening!

The Galas are a highlight of Nationals! It's a chance for dancers, families, and studios to celebrate their achievements together in style. Dress to impress - this is a fun, semi-formal occasion! Each dancer's registration includes Gala admission for the dancer and two guests, with seats organized by your studio owner prior to the event. There are no physical tickets, just assigned studio sections. The 12 & Under Dance Off and Gala is on July 5th, and the 13 & Over Dance Off and Gala is on July 8th.

DANCER OF THE YEAR

The next level of competition for regional Ultimate Challenge winners is America's Dancer of the Year (DOTY) where winners from each regional event will vie for the coveted title of America's Dancer of the Year. Contestants not only perform their solo, but they are also judged in audition classes and featured in a show-stopping Opening Number! The solo performance evenings are open for the public to attend, so stop in and watch some amazing talent take the stage!
